2 Enrolment Process:

How can I secure my child's enrolment at Mansfield State School?

- ✓ Collect an enrolment pack from the office during the Parent Information Session or download from the school website.
- ✓ Complete the enrolment pack and submit **all** required documentation including the Student Information Interview Form.
- ✓ Book and attend an interview with your child.

3 Book an interview:

How will the school get to know my child?

- ✓ Book an interview timeslot when contacted by the office.
- ✓ Attend the interview with your child, ensuring all the necessary paperwork is at hand.

4 Participate in Transition Opportunities:

How will my child get to know the school?

- ✓ **Mansfield Minis Program:** supports both children and parents with the transition into Prep over a two-week period. The sessions commence in September Term 3. You will book your session at your interview.
- ✓ **Orientation Day:** supports children to transition into a working classroom for the morning similar to what they can expect on arrival at 'big school' in 2027.
